Protect your bicycle from thieves!



Bicycle Theft Prevention Registration



《Registering your bicycle is a legal requirement》

In trying to find your lost bicycle, Theft Prevention Registration (Bohan Toroku) is not only a requirement but also a key to finding your bicycle in any way.

Registering your bicycle may prevent thieves from stealing your bicycle, and is useful for finding your bicycle if stolen.





"Theft Prevention Registration" (600 yen) can be done at your nearest Crime Prevention Association office (which is usually located in each Police Station), and Police Box or Residential Police Box

Your Theft Prevention Registration will be valid for 10 years from the day of your registration completion.

《Use two locks!》

If there are multiple locks, thieves may hesitate to steal your bicycle because breaking two locks would take a longer time to steal your bicycle.

* About 60% of the stolen bicycles were not locked when stolen; about 40% had only a single lock.





In cases of giving or selling your bicycle to a third party, be sure to deregister your bicycle beforehand.

Deregistering is a process to register that you are no longer the owner of the bicycle, without which the new owner will not be able to register the bicycle as his/hers.

Visit your nearest Crime Prevention Association office, and Police Box or Residential Police Box for deregistration.
